

Enrollment Trends

- Declining enrollment
 - Lost 1404 students since 2002
 - Lost 569 students since 2014
 - Projected decline for next ten years
- Funding tied to enrollment
 - Deficit budgets last three years
 - Impacting ability to attract and retain staff
 - Impacting ability to provide opportunities for students



Aging Facilities


- Five buildings built before 1940 at the end of their designed life
- \$76 M in identified districtwide maintenance, \$1.2 M annual maintenance budget
- Six oldest buildings do not meet current educational needs

Strategy

Close. Closing inefficient and high maintenance buildings will reduce operating costs, eliminate anticipated and deferred maintenance costs, and right size facilities with enrollment.

Consolidate. Consolidating facilities will create staffing efficiencies, provide more opportunities for students, and right size facilities with enrollment.

Build. Renovating or building new schools will provide students with modern learning environments.
