


INFLATION

Throughout all of these challenges, financing has remained relatively cheap and available...continuing to drive demand!





Inflation Impacts ON PROJECTS

INFLATION IS NOT EQUAL


- New construction vs. renovation
- Amount and types of material impact cost
- How work is contracted and pricing is locked in determines future cost risk



Materials with MAJOR INFLATION

GENERAL CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS

- Lumber (down from last year, but climbing again)
- Steel
 - Sheet steel (ductwork, metal studs)
 - o Pipe
 - Structural steel
- Petroleum products
- Many others...




Schedule IMPACTS

GENERAL CONSTRUCTION MATERIALS

- Steel joists & steel decking (6–8 months)
- Urethane products
- Roof insulation (6+ months)
- Wood doors (5 months)
- Mineral wool insulation (6 months)
- Overhead doors (6–8 months)
- Walk in coolers (4 -12 months)
- Many smaller items delayed too


(Delays based on recent supplier feedback, list not exhaustive and lead times will vary)



Schedule IMPACTS

ELECTRICAL

- Generators (64 weeks)
- Electrical gear (36 weeks)
 - Breakers
 - Panels (12-16 weeks)
- Transformers (56 weeks)
- Fire alarm equipment
- Various plastic components
- Lights, LED (24 weeks)



Work Process IMPACTS


PRE-PLANNING

- Condensed
- Heightened awareness
- Attention to all materials

ACQUISITION OF PRODUCT

- Take delivery
- Warehousing Storage
- Reduce "Just in time" orders and deliveries



MECHANICAL MATERIALS


- RTU's & AHU's(22 26 weeks)
- ECM-driven fans (good luck)
- Chillers (24 40 weeks)
- VFD's (up to 40 weeks)
- Pumps (14 24 weeks)
- VAV boxes (8 12 weeks)
- Pipe & fittings (varies)



Work Procurement IMPACTS

DESIGN ASSIST

- Early MEP contractor involvement
- Better knowledge of market
- Fast-track procurement
- Ability to store equipment & materials
- Leverage to address delays






Early Engagement with PROJECT PARTNERS


ONBOARD YOUR TEAM EARLY

- Designers
- Contractors, Subcontractors, Critical Suppliers
- Discuss procurement methods and options
- Understand how your budgets are assembled and what is included in them




Order Materials **EARLY**

- What materials need to be procured early?
- Can aspects of a design be accelerated to meet this?
- Does changing products improve lead times?
- Can you store materials to ensure they are onsite when you need them?
- Expedite submittal review.




Track Materials CONSTANTLY

- Confirm the subcontractors and vendors have released orders to the manufacturers
- Delays in shipping and in transit are more common
 - Have you talked recently to suppliers?
 - Confirm they have requested updated ship dates from the manufacturers.
 - Is the information you have received consistent?



Contingency PLANNING


- Confirm status of materials before beginning work
- Develop alternate plans in case of delays in materials
- Consider ordering materials early & storing them



What's **NEXT?**

Should I still proceed with my project?

- What does it cost to wait?
- What will happen with inflation?
- Where will the market be in 6 or 12 months?




Current markets conditions are expected to continue for the foreseeable future!

- Have contingency plans & maintain adaptability


