
MYTHS AND MISCONCEPTIONS ABOUT LEADERSHIP

CHARACTER LEVERAGES COMPETENCY

Competency is the skill set, technical knowledge, and ability to perform a task or job. Competency is **what we do**. Character is **who we are** and **how we do** what we do. It's the "soft" skills, such as attitude, work ethic, integrity, leadership, and ability to work with others. 87% of our results is determined by character.



Leadership is one of the most profoundly complex, and at the same time, incredibly simple concepts. John C. Maxwell states it well, "Leadership is influence." Influence is simple and easy to understand. If you are influencing someone to do, say, or think something different, you are leading them. But understanding why, how, when and who you are influencing becomes very complex. Leadership is complex because it's primarily increased by developing your character.

CHARACTERISTICS OF VERY SUCCESSFUL LEADERS

1. BE PROACTIVE

- To be proactive is to respond to any given situation based on values instead of emotions.
- When we are proactive, we greatly increase the amount of influence we have with other people. Our ability to lead (influence) increases exponentially when we can first lead and influence ourselves well.

2. BE AUTHENTIC

- There is a paradox in authenticity because we all want authenticity in everything and everyone else, but we struggle to be authentic ourselves.
- Authenticity requires us to be vulnerable. And, vulnerability is commonly, and incorrectly, perceived as a weakness.

3. BE RESILIENT

 Resilience is the ability to recover, to spring back, to thrive, and to become strong after, or in spite of, tough times. Resilience is one of the qualities we admire most and expect most in our leaders.

4. BE CONFIDENT

- Self-confidence is conviction of your values and core beliefs enhanced by experience and lessons learned from both successes and failures.
- Situational-confidence is certainty in the outcome of a situation which is enhanced by your knowledge, skills, and abilities.

5. BEINTENTIONAL
