





Wisconsin Policy Forum releases School DataTool

By the Wisconsin Policy Forum

Enrollment in Wisconsin public and charter schools stabilized in 2021 but failed to recoup any of the decrease of more than 25,000 students that occurred the previous year, according to the findings of a newly updated data tool from the Wisconsin Policy Forum. Meanwhile, graduation and attendance rates declined statewide amid a slew of pandemic-related disruptions. There was also a decline in the share of students scoring proficient or advanced on the Forward Exam, though this metric is not easy to interpret due to a huge increase in the share of students who opted out of the statewide standardized tests.

These are among the key findings of the Forum's updated School DataTool. This online interactive tool allows for comparison of each of Wisconsin's public school districts on metrics relating to student participation, school district spending, graduation rates, test scores, and other measures of student performance.


This latest edition of the tool is the fourth since its 2019 debut. It includes the most recent available data, which goes through the 2020-21 school year for some indicators and 2021-22 for others.
